## Pastor's Page

*"I wish somebody would have stopped me."*

Today I met a lady who does post-abortion counseling, who told me that, no matter what the circumstances leading up to the abortion, no matter what the socio-economic class of the woman, no matter how old or young, married or not, one thing they all have in common is this sentence, "I wish somebody would have stopped me."

She also mentioned some of the statistics concerning abortion, including the surveys that indicate that, of every six women undergoing an abortion, one is a regular attender of a Christian church.

All the numbers tell me that it's likely that someone reading this newsletter has been involved in an abortion. It's well known that Trinity, along with our Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod, teaches that God says no to abortion, and

we talk about that from time to time. What I'm concerned about is that the word "abortion" is so politically charged that the important things we need to say about the subject won't actually be heard.

So I'm asking you, no matter how much or how little your life has been touched by abortion, to take a few minutes to listen and pray.

The message we have to share concerning

## Visioning Trinity Downtown

Visioning Trinity Downtown  
(Travelodge Property)

At its April 9, 2006 meeting, Trinity voters approved the following recommendations from the Development Committee:

1. That Trinity submit a Contract for Purchase to the owners of the Travelodge

property to be executed by Trinity's Trustees.

*Terms of contract:*  
Purchase Price: \$3.5 million  
Due Diligence: 90 Days -  
\$50,000 Close on Contract:  
Six months after Due Diligence Period.

The contract for purchase presents a 90 day due

diligence period allowing Trinity to further determine the feasibility of continuing with the project. The sum of \$50,000 will be placed in escrow during this 90-day period. At the end of the 90-day period Trinity may decide not to continue the project. If so, the \$50,000 escrowed will be returned to Trinity. If Trinity decides to close on the contract, the \$50,000 will be credited

abortion is a message of both Law and Gospel. What that means is that God has things to say about abortion to people who are contemplating it as an option, and also has things to say to those whose lives have already been impacted by it. Those words from God will not be the same words.

Let me give an example. If your child is about to run out into a busy street, your message needs to be very clear—"Do not run out into that street!" You might need to grab and hold onto the child, or speak warnings of the dire consequences of running into the street. But if your child has just run into the street, been grazed by a car, and is now in your arms crying, frightened, and sorry for what he's done, your message is very different—"I love you, I'll take care of you, I forgive you." There might come a good teaching moment later, after the immediate fright is past, a time to say, "What happened there is the reason for our rule about running into the street," but until about Jesus' willingness to go to the cross for her, about the peace and comfort that God offers to those who bring their sins to him.

Even many Christian churches don't handle this well. One of the main responsibilities we have as Lutheran Christians is to bear witness to other Christians that God speaks both Law and Gospel, not only Law or only Gospel. We don't stop saying "Abortion is against God's Law," but we also must continue to show the love of Jesus who said, "Come unto me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest."

If you're a person whose involvement with an abortion has you struggling (even if you're not the mother), I would be happy to sit with you and help you work through this. I think I've been here long enough for most of you to trust me, and I hope, if you're struggling, you'll recognize that this is an invitation from your pastor, who loves you, to rediscover how much God really loves you.

#### Stephen Ministers: The After People

Trinity began Stephen Ministry in June, 2000 in a response to God's love and Jesus' command "Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." John 13:34

Stephen Ministers answer this call in a special way by "being there" for individuals in crisis or for those who need a Christian presence in a life struggle. Stephen Ministers bring Jesus' love to those in need and no one is exempt from the problems of everyday life. By listening, being there and ministering with Christian resources such as prayer, blessings and sharing Scriptures, Stephen Ministers help in a special way.

Prayer keeps the lines open between people and God. Praying specifically for needs brings spiritual strength to ministry. Stephen Ministers pray for and with their care receivers praying their hearts will be opened to God's love and God's answers as He reveals them. Stephen Ministers also pray for and with each other as Stephen Ministers daily as well as during Ongoing Education/Peer Supervision meetings.

Trinity recently commissioned five new Stephen Ministers : Karen Arnett, Carolyn Davenport, Leo and Stephanie Nagy and Gary Oakley. This is the fourth class of Stephen Ministers to receive approximately 50 hours of training in distinctively Christian care-giving. Stephen Ministers commit to a two year term of training and service. Stephen Ministers are each assigned a care receiver to

meet with for about an hour a week. This caring relationship lasts as long as needed. If you would like more information and/or if you or someone you know (please obtain their permission) could be served by such care please call Pastor at 407-422-5704.
