Please call us at these times:

- when you schedule your surgery date—we'd like to pray with you before the surgery
- if your surgery is cancelled or postponed
- when you enter the hospital, either through the ER or regular admissions (obviously you may need someone else to make that call!)
- when you're leaving the hospital—because of privacy laws, the hospital can't tell us if you went home, went to rehab or even passed away!
- when illness will keep you out of church for more than a Sunday or two
- when you desire communion for any reason
