### **Philosophy**

In response to God's love and His command to share his Gospel it is our philosophy to educate children based on the Word of God.

It is the aim of Trinity Lutheran Church and School's Athletic Program to facilitate this through sports activities. Through a student's participation in interscholastic sports, it is hoped that the student will further develop spiritually, mentally, physically and socially. Students will be encouraged to be the best they can be by doing the best they can to the glory of Christ.

### **Goals**

1. To glorify Jesus Christ in all that is done on and off the playing field/court.
2. To understand how the use of physical skills can be a form of worship.
3. To help establish a firmer and more personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
4. To realize the importance of people in their lives and the value of working cooperatively, in a team effort.
5. To develop the effective control of emotions and decision-making in a Christ-like manner.
6. To foster a lifelong enjoyment of sports and recreational activities, while at the same time learning the importance of discipline and respect.
7. To provide an additional avenue to promote school spirit and unity.
8. To model the qualities of commitment, loyalty and discipline.
9. To develop the God-given talents of the individual.

### **Parental Role**

The parents of a student are usually the determining factor in their child's decision to become an athlete. Because we encourage all of our children to be a Christian first, student second and an athlete third, the responsibilities of the parents play a vital role in the child becoming a total complete student athlete at Trinity. Some of these responsibilities are listed below.

1. Teach by example Christian attitude towards all. The school can only support and encourage the basics taught in the home.

2. Assist the child to establish proper priorities with respect church, peers, study and play.
3. Encourage and participate in the development of the student athlete's abilities.  
     Support the student athlete's commitment to groups and teams
4. Develop within each student athlete foresight, which enables him/her to accept Responsibility for both his/her own acts of the group of which he/she are a part of
5. Instill in the student athlete good health habits.
6. Make a commitment to help the athletes by attending sporting events, selling at concession stands, assisting in clean up, and encouraging coaches.
7. Enthusiastically support the teams at athletic events without being over zealous or critical of coaches, officials or the opposing team.
8. If a parent has a concern that he/she needs to voice, it should first be shared with the person whom it involves at the proper time, and in a CHRIST-LIKE way
9. Be responsible for his/her child's promptness for games and practices. Also, to be prompt in picking up children from games and practices.
10. Exemplifying everything a Christian parent would want to see in his/her student athlete.

### **Eligibility to Participate in School Athletics**

Trinity Lutheran Church and School, as a member of the Central Florida Athletic Association and the Orlando Metro League, participates in interscholastic sports of soccer, volleyball, basketball, track, golf, flag football and cheerleading with other Lutheran, Christian, and private schools. Students in grades 5-8 are eligible to participate. Fifth and sixth grade students are considered Junior Varsity while seventh and eighth graders are considered Varsity. Participation in Trinity Lutheran's sports program, where the student is representing the school to the general public, is a privilege afforded to any student who meets minimum academic, social, and behavioral expectations.

Students must be under 15 years of age before September 1 to be eligible for the varsity level of competition. Students must be under 13 years of age before September 1 to be eligible for junior varsity. A **junior varsity** player may be brought up to the varsity level. This may only be done during the season if there is a problem of numbers. If they remain with the Varsity team that player or players become ineligible for the junior varsity tournament.

At the end of the Junior Varsity season a player may be moved to the Varsity for the remainder of the Varsity season.

Full-time Trinity students in grades 5-8 are eligible to participate if they meet the following standards:

1. Students must have a current physical on file in the school office and an emergency card on file in the Athletic Director's office prior to participation in try-outs, practices, or games before the beginning of the season.
2. Students need to maintain a 75% GPA or higher and must not receive a grade below 65% in any subject including enrichment subjects. A student who has not met these standards on the mid-term or report card will be placed on a two-week academic probation and will not be allowed to practice or participate in games. The probation begins the day grades are sent home. A student may be placed on academic probation at the beginning of the school year based on the last report card of the previous year. The student will be reinstated at the end of the probation period. if he/she has met the eligibility requirements. If students do not meet the requirements at the end of the probation period they will remain ineligible until the end of the grading period.
3. All students must exhibit a sincere effort to do the assigned school work. It is important for the students to complete all missing assignments during the Probation period as well as completing current assignments. If students have Study hall during the school day, they should use that time effectively to complete Assignments. Study halls are also scheduled in after school care and are supervised by middle school teachers.
4. In order for a student to participate in athletics a student must be in class the day of the event. For a weekend event, the student must be in school the Friday before the event. This requirement maybe waived at the discretion of the principal and athletic director.
5. At Trinity the student is a Christian first, student second, and an athlete third. Being a member of a sports team is a privilege not a right. The student is expected to be a good example for others to follow. In the event that the student fails to exemplify a Christian attitude and good behavior, it may be necessary to remove the student from the team. The length of removal will be determined by the Principal and Athletic Director.

### **Team Selection and Tryouts**

All 5<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades students will be invited to participate in every sport as listed in the above. The number of students to participate on teams will be as follows:

1. Boy's Soccer - 18
2. Volleyball - 12
3. Basketball - 12
4. Cheerleading – 12
5. Girls Soccer – 14
6. Flag Football – 14
7. Golf – Minimum 4
8. Track

If the number of students in advance of a sport exceeds the maximum number by three or more students, then three or more students may not make the team.

If the coach chooses to carry more than the recommended number of students, he/she

will carry these students in order to allow them to improve and develop their skills. It must be understood that a player who is number 13, 14, or 15 on a team of twelve will have limited playing time.

### **Interscholastic Sports**

FALL (*Aug. - Oct.*):

1. Volleyball: Girls 5-8

2. Soccer: Boys 5 – 8

WINTER (Oct. – Feb.):

3. Basketball: Girls 5 – 8, Boys 5 – 8

4. Cheerleading: Girls grades 5 – 8

Cheerleading runs in accordance with the basketball season. However, cheerleading practices/camps occur before and after the season has been completed.

SPRING (Feb. – May):

5. Track and Field: Girls 5 – 8, Boys 5 – 8

6. Golf : Girls 5 – 8, Boys 5 – 8

7. Soccer Girls grades 5 – 8

8. Flag Football Boys grades 6 – 8

### **Practices**

1. Schedules – The Athletic Director will provide parents with a practice /game schedule prior to the start of each sport season. Parents will be informed of any schedule changes through the school news letter, email, and special notes.
2. Students are expected to attend every practice. More than one unexcused absence will be cause for suspension or removal from a team. Exception cases are left to the discretion of the coach.
3. An unexcused practice before a game will cause the student athlete to be ineligible for a portion of the next scheduled game.

### **Commitment**

In order to promote loyalty for the Trinity Lutheran Church and School Athletic program and permit more time to concentrate on academic work, students will be encouraged to participate only on Trinity sport teams during the school year. Students, who participate on a team, other than a Trinity team during the same season, are to present the schedule of their other team to the Athletic Director. If it is the opinion of the Athletic Director that there are too many conflicts, then the student may be asked to choose of which team he/she desires to participate.

### **Parking**

Parking can be an issue at times here at Trinity. In hopes to a leave some of the difficulties we have had in the past we are asking that parents staying for sporting events park in the Ministry Center parking lot across from the portable class rooms on the west side of campus. We request that you NOT park in the Ruth lane parking lot. This lot will be reserved for parents who are picking their child up after school and will only be parked for a 5-10 minute period. Thank you for your cooperation.

### **Transportation and Lodging for Athletic Events**

When the bus is the mode of transportation, all team members are required to ride the bus to the game. If a parent is driving to an away game and plans on taking his/her child home, please make sure to inform the coach. If you are planning on driving another student home, you need a written note from that student's parent stating that you take full responsibility for that student. The coach must have the letter in his/her hands before the bus leaves.

When students are competing in a tournament hosted by another school parents are responsible to transport their child to and from the event. If an overnight stay is required then it is the responsibility of the parent to make motel arrangements.

### **Athletic Budget**

The athletic budget is funded in two ways. First, with a sports fee paid by each student for each sport he/she participates in, and the second is financial assistance given by the Boosters.

### **Boosters**

The Booster Club was started to assist the Athletic Department. As parents of a student participating on a Trinity Lutheran Church and School team you are a member of the Booster Club. As a member you are required to help whenever possible

Some services needed but not limited to be as follow:

2. Runs and assist with, providing hospitality at the concession stand.
3. Assist with fund raising.
4. Help with tournaments.
5. Sports banquets
6. Keeping time or score at games
7. Special events

### **Extended Care**

Students remaining after school, waiting for practice to begin at 5:00 are to check into Extended Care. Students who are not picked up after practice will be sent to Extended Care. In either case parents will be charged \$ 8.00 per day.

### **Trinity Lutheran School Parents and Player Code of Conduct**

The sports program at Trinity Lutheran Church and School is viewed as a way to create a well-rounded program for the students we service every year. Sports should be treated as secondary to the student's academic work. Athletics offers a student the opportunity to become a TEAM player rather than a "lone" player. It also helps to foster high Christian standards in word and deed. Furthermore, participation is a privilege, not a right. Keeping this in mind there are some standards we need to adhere to.

Trinity Lutheran Church and School has developed the following Code of Conduct for parents as well as players to show an understanding of what is expected here at Trinity Lutheran. Parents and students together are to read and discuss the following Code of Conduct to show an understanding of what is expected of you here at Trinity Lutheran. Please sign and return the Code of Conduct to the Athletic Director.

### **Parents Code of Conduct**

As a parent of a player representing Trinity Lutheran Church and School, I will adhere to the following:

1. I will support my child unconditionally; regardless of well he/she performs.
2. I will support his/her coach by letting the coach know that I appreciate the teamwork, sportsmanship, fundamentals he/she is promoting and the time he/she is putting in to help my son/daughter.

3. I will support his/her team no matter who plays and who doesn't play, who plays well and who does not play well, no matter whether his/her team wins or loses. Support ALL the players on the team and will NEVER criticize another player on the team.
4. I will treat other players, coaches, officials and fans with respect. No rude or discourteous behavior from the bleachers or sidelines during games or practices.
5. I will support coaches and officials working with my son/daughter, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience.
6. I will help the team whenever possible by providing my service through, Trinity Boosters, helping with concessions, tournaments, special events, fund raising, sports banquets, keeping time and score and other options provided by the athletic department.
7. I will have fun and promise to help my child enjoy their experience.

**Player Code of Conduct**

As a player representing Trinity Lutheran Church and School, I will adhere to the follow:

1. I will treat teammates, coaches, referees and /or officials, opponents, spectators, and all others involved in our athletic event with respect at all times.
2. I will give my best effort and full attention to my coach, and do my best to follow their instruction during games and practices. I will attend

all practices and games, as detailed on my schedule.

2. I will encourage and help my teammates no matter who plays and who does not play, who plays well and who does not play well, whether we win or lose.
3. I will work personally to improve my Christian values and athletic skills each day.
4. I will have fun.

As a member of a Trinity Lutheran Church and School team, I understand that I am responsible for my conduct at all times during practices and games. I agree to conduct myself in a Christian manner and to show Good Sportsmanship at all times.

It has been made clear to me that one incident of unsatisfactory conduct will result in my sitting out for one game. The second offense will result in dismissal from the team. Unsatisfactory conduct includes but is not limited to:

1. Rude or discourteous behavior to the coaches, referee, teammates or spectators.
2. Displaying an attitude, which shows I am not taking responsibility for my own behavior.
3. Any use of inappropriate language towards the coach, referee, teammates or spectators.
4. "Fooling around" at practice or games.
5. Being "red carded" or ejected from a game.
6. Behavior, which would place my teammates or myself in an unsafe situation.
